The mission of the IFSTL is to train domestic and foreign nationals in food testing protocols involving chemical and microbiological contamination. The successful candidate will work with the IFSTL Manager to train domestic and foreign nationals in fit-for-purpose analytical techniques and methodology required to carry out analysis of microbiological contaminants in foods.

The is a non-tenure track faculty position with a 12-month appointment.

The primary duties of the position are:

• In consultation with the Laboratory Manager, participate in the development of the IFSTL Microbiology laboratory program and learning goals for each laboratory course. Coordinate the group instructors and experts involved in the delivery of individual courses.

• Supervising the microbiology laboratory during training sessions and act as the primary instructor for up to 20 laboratory training courses per year.

• Select, develop and/ or improve experiments to achieve the course learning goals.

• Insuring that all experiments work as anticipated and can be performed concomitantly by 20 trainees.

• Prepare hand-outs, manuals and other course material in collaboration with outside trainers and the Laboratory Manager.

• Participate in other JIFSAN activities occurring in the IFSTL laboratories for both chemistry and microbiology programs.

Other principle duties include:

• Coordinating the laboratory activities for Microbiology.

• Preparing (writing and/or editing) the in-house lab manual; assuring that sufficient copies of the manual are available to the students before the training session begins.

• Working with the stockroom managers on campus and with vendors to assure that the appropriate equipment, chemicals and supplies for each experiment are available.

• Coordinating and supervising graduate teaching assistants when present.

• Carrying out IFSTL administrative and other duties as required

Required: Ph.D. degree in Microbiology, Food Science or related field. Knowledge of scientific computer systems and standard office software. Strong personal communication skills are essential.
