SENASICA

(Ministry of Agriculture of Mexico)

- Process: to obtain the technical elements that allow SENASICA to give recognition to GFSI recognized CPOs to issue homologous certifications for SRRC (Senasica Contamination Risk Reduction System).
- Objective: a GFSI audit will include SRRC requirements that will ensure SENASICA to not perform a public inspection on the GFSI certified site.

MINAGRO

(Ministry of Agri-business of Argentina)

- Provide a comparative analysis between GFSI BR 7.2 & Argentina voluntary quality stamp
- Propose a pathway to upgrade the quality stamp with GFSI BR requirements using the GMaP pathway to do so.

ACHIPIA

(Chilean FS Authority)

- MOU includes collaboration on the Global Markets Programme, Food safety culture and better representation of Chile and Latam at the global level
